

Appendix B:

Criteria for 2023/2024

- 1. Organisations must demonstrate that their activities meet one or more of the following objectives:**

The provision of support or services that:

- support people to be able to live independently for as long as possible.
- support people to improve their emotional and physical health.
- target services at under-represented and / or seldom heard groups.
- effectively safeguard people from abuse, neglect, or poor treatment.
- reduce social isolation.
- help reduce reliance on alternative, higher cost state interventions.
- support and enable carers to carry on caring for as long as possible.
- Help increase youth provision across the district.

- 2. The Council will exclude any applications that link to:**

- rent / lease costs.
- building maintenance.
- vehicle maintenance / running costs.

- 3. Organisations must be able to demonstrate the impact that their project will have in terms of number of people to benefit and the outcomes that will be achieved.**

- 4. Organisations, must demonstrate:**

- a genuine need for financial assistance.
- that they are financially sustainable.
- that they are fully constituted, with an equalities statement, health and safety policy and public liability insurance and bank account with two signatories.

- 5. The Council must not be the sole contributor towards the activity in question (i.e., funding should also be forthcoming from the organisation itself and/or other sources).**

- 6. National charities and organisations must demonstrate that the grant will be used to support the Health & Wellbeing of residents living in Tandridge.**
