I am a Superintendent in the Surrey Police Force.

I am giving this certificate because I am of the opinion that other procedures under the Licensing Act are inappropriate because:

From 22:27 hours on Saturday 3rd July 2021, Police were called via multiple 999 calls to the SPAGHETTI TREE, LIMPSFIELD ROAD, WARLINGHAM, for a large fight at the location. There had been a private ticketed party that evening, where guests had purchased tickets for table service dinner and drinks outdoors. From looking at the guest list there appears to have been in excess of 100 people in attendance. CCTV from the premises and captured on personal mobile phones shows a violent disorder where numerous persons fighting used glass bottles ,drinking glasses, other ornaments and furniture as weapons .CCTV also shows persons being punched and kicked and it also appears a glass bottle has been used to assault a male on the ground. Police have currently recorded 1 x GBH and 7 x ABH, following this disorder. High levels of intoxication have been recorded by officers.

Surrey Police believe that only suspension of the premises licence as an interim step will prevent the risk of further serious crime and disorder being committed on the premises, .Numerous persons are still to be identified and arrested and it cannot be ruled out that persons who would be present at the venue when licensable activity takes place may now be subject to reprisals. There is also a requirement to provide reassurance to the local community whilst next steps in relation to the premises licence are reviewed.
